## J. Gary Sparks The Self on Fire

The workshop will explore the relationship between erotic desire and conscious selfhood. We will begin by discussing Eros from the Jungian view in order to understand the fiery aspects of our own emotional life. A series of dreams concerning the healing of anorexia nervosa through erotic desire in the therapeutic relationship will further illustrate Jung's psychological reflections on sexual attraction. In light of these practical experiences, we will consider as our guiding metaphor *The Psychology of the Transference*, Jung's crowning essay on the relation between sexual fantasies and emotional maturity. This will be a multimedia seminar format—including time for reflective discussion.
